Known as the home of Toyota, Aichi also offers samurai history, unique local foods, great nightlife, rustic beauty and distinctive arts and crafts.



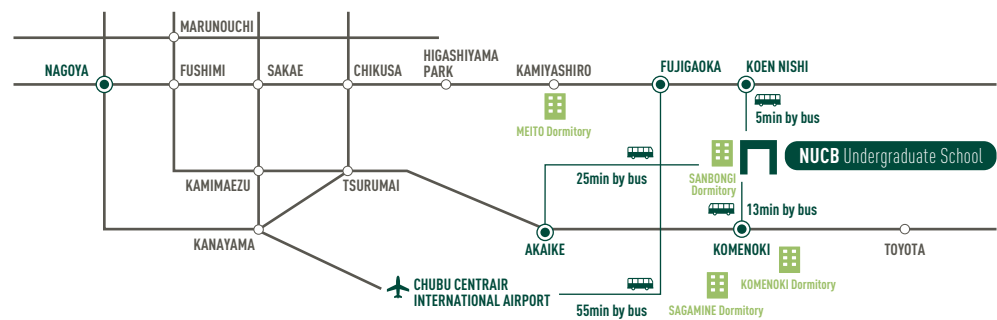




# INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY

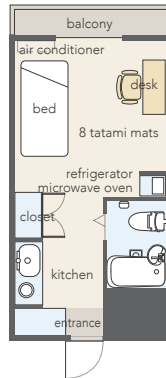

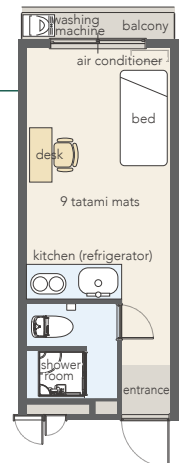


## SANBONGI

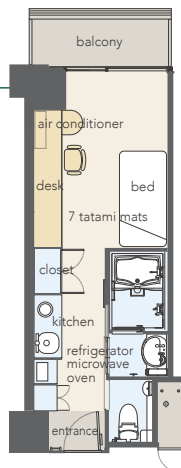


## MEITO

■ 198 rooms / 9 floors

Located in Nagoya's Meito Ward, a quiet residential area near downtown Nagoya, each room comes fully furnished with appliances and complimentary WiFi. Additionally, there is a coin laundry facility located on-site. For added security, there are female-only floors accessible via key card. The nearest stations, Kamiyashiro and Issha, are just a 15-minute walk away. Plus, there's a supermarket next to the dormitory.





## KOMENOKI

Just a 10-minute bus ride to the Nisshin campus, all rooms are fully furnished with appliances, and a coin laundry facility located on-site. A supermarket, drug store, and convenience store are located nearby.

## HIGASHIYAMA GLOBAL CENTER

Established in 2010, this residential facility exclusively serves NUCB Graduate School students, offering 44 private rooms, seminar spaces, a library, and a fitness center. Situated in Nagoya's suburbs, it's just a five-minute walk from the nearest train station, and offers a relaxing living space.



## CHIYODA RESIDENCE

Primarily used by NUCB Graduate School students, Chiyoda provides 94 fully furnished rooms. Situated near Sakae, Nagoya's downtown, it's easily accessible from anywhere in the city.

### NUCB IBDP Scholarship

We offer a unique scholarship for students taking the IB Diploma. Those who score 32 points or higher out of a maximum of 42 points will receive a minimum discount of 300,000 JPY on annual tuition. The scholarship is guaranteed for the first two years.

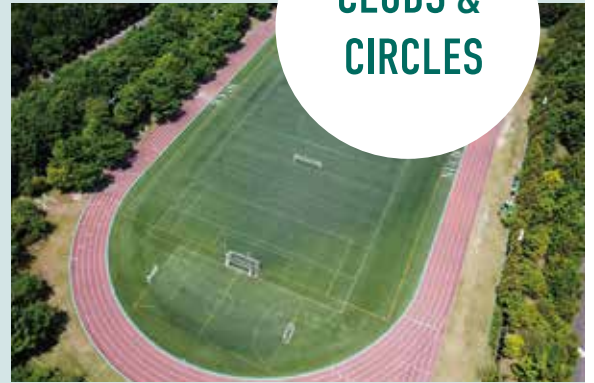
Moreover, recent renovations have been made to our training plaza, and we now offer a prayer room for students, staff, and faculty members to practice their religious beliefs.
